White Goods/Metal Curbside Pick-up -
 October and May - collection dates posted on town website
 Must remove oil, gasoline, and doors from items for safety.

Hazardous Waste Event
 October 28, 2017 at the Masconomet Regional High School from 9:00AM to 1:00PM

Drop-off Recycling Center in Boxford -
 Open to Topsfield residents, Located behind DPW Garage, 7B Spofford Road. (fees may apply)
 Saturdays from 8 am - 3:30 pm; TVs, computers, car batteries, large home appliances and much more collected here.
 Motor Oil is accepted on the first Saturday of the month from 8 am - noon.

Leaves and Yard Waste: Topsfield DPW Facility, 279 Boston St. Saturdays from 9 AM to 1 PM.

There is a fee to drop-off leaves and yard waste. Residents can go to the Selectmen's Office in Town Hall and purchase a Compost Access Ticket for \$10. Each ticket will allow the disposal of up to 2 cubic yards (a standard body pick-up truck) of material per visit. Each visit will require a separate access ticket.

Curbside Collection Information

Paper

Place in Paper Bag

- Newspapers/inserts
- Magazines, catalogs
- Phone books, junk mail
- Office paper
- Paperboard (cereal, cracker boxes). Remove plastic liners
- Corrugated cardboard, flatten
- **NO** Soiled/greasy cardboard

Containers

Place in Bin

- Glass bottles/jars, all colors & sizes
- Aluminum/tin/steel cans and lids
- Plastic containers
- Milk cartons and juice boxes
- **NO** items containing paint, aerosol or hazardous materials
- **NO** broken glass, window glass, dishes, Pyrex, ceramics
- **NO** plastic bags, styrofoam.
